## Broadband Technical Assistance Funding Opportunity Deadline June 20, 2023

The newly announced Broadband Technical Assistance (BTA) Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) has been published

in the Federal Register. The \$20 million available for BTA is made possible by funding the USDA Rural Utilities Service (RUS) received in the <u>Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act</u> (IIJA) (Pub. L. 117-58).

Broadband Technical Assistance refers to activities that support broadband expansion into rural areas and may include:

- Project planning and community engagement
- Financial sustainability
- Environmental compliance
- Construction planning and engineering
- Accessing federal resources
- Data collection and reporting

The RUS is accepting applications from broadband technical assistance providers, recipients, and entities proposing projects that would support the growth or expansion of a broadband cooperative that would serve rural communities. Applications must be submitted through <a href="https://grants.gov">https://grants.gov</a> by 11:59 PM Eastern on June 20, 2023.
