New Mexico's Coordinator for the federal Broadband Equity Access and Deployment (BEAD) program will be at the 2024 New Mexico Broadband Summit!

The Summit will be held on **October 29** at the Isleta Resort and Casino.

Andrew Wilder will be attending the Summit and will be available to answer questions about the program. BEAD is the state's largest broadband funding program. The federal government has allocated \$675 million for New Mexico to award grants for broadband infrastructure deployment.

The BEAD application process is underway, and now is the time to get involved if you want to apply. Andrew will be on hand to answer questions about the BEAD application process, requirements, and timeline as the state moves forward with this historic investment in connectivity for New Mexicans

At the Summit you'll have an opportunity to speak to Andrew and members of the OBAE team!
